RE: Southern Nevada Health District Weekly COVID-19 response Update

The following is a summary of recent developments in response to COVID-19:

- Vaccine updates for first and second doses are frequently posted to the Health District's website. Current information is highly accurate, and it is recommended to be reviewed for all questions. Appointments are required; walk-ins for first doses are not permitted. Appointment availability opens up to seven days in advance.

- Recent updates to vaccination process and availability:
 - People 65 years of age and older are now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine in Clark County.
 - A state-wide centralized call-center/helpline for all COVID vaccinations needs is now available. This number replaces any previous Health District helpline. Appointments can be scheduled/canceled. **1-800-401-0946**
 - First and second dose vaccination sites include the Health District, Cashman Center, Desert Pines HS, and Las Vegas Convention Center. Limited vaccinations are being offered at alternating senior centers to increase access for seniors. Any person with mobility issues is recommended to schedule their appointment at the Health District 280 S Decatur.
 - Cold weather has delayed vaccine shipments. Any second-dose canceled appointments will be contacted and provided support to reschedule. Any cancellation may call 1-800-401-0946 to reschedule. First-dose appointments will be limited or unavailable next week due to the delay. Please visit the Health District's website or call the helpline for up-to-date information on vaccine availability.
 - UMC's COVID Vaccination Center at the Encore Las Vegas is vaccinating community members 65 and older. To schedule an appointment, please visit their website at www.umcsn.com/COVIDvaccine or call 702-789-5160. Appointments are required and available on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE), through UNLV Student Union and CSN Henderson Campus, coordinates the COVID vaccine for Pre-Schools, K-12 Education, Substitute Teachers, Colleges, and Universities. To schedule an appointment, please visit their website.
 - Please contact any pharmacy directly for information
- The Governor has issued guidance to begin a gradual lifting of current mitigation measures. Please visit <https://nvhealthresponse.nv.gov/current-status-mitigation-measures/> for information.
- The submission process for large-gathering plans is available with Clark County Business License. The Health District's Environmental Health and Office of Epidemiology and Disease Surveillance will review plans and submit recommendations to ensure adequate health infrastructure is in
